Breakfast Served to **400** Children in Telangana

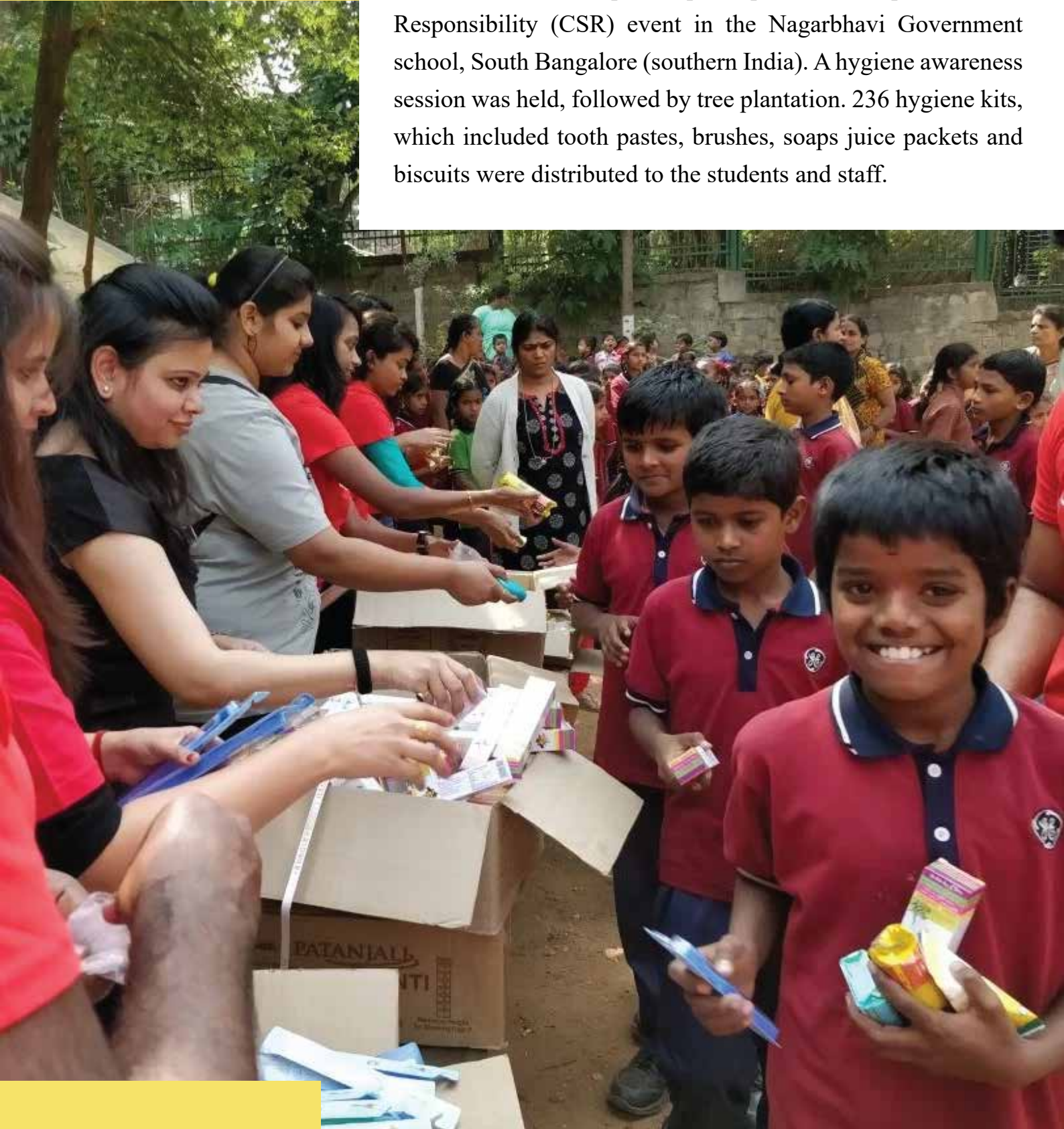
